- 1. Welcome. Dr. Joel Pawlak welcomed the group and called the meeting to order at 12:01pm.
- 2. <u>Previous Minutes.</u> The minutes of the April 27, 2018 meeting were reviewed, and with no recommendations for edits,

It was MOVED to:

"Approve the minutes of the April 2018 Council on Athletics meeting."

(APPROVED – Unanimously)

3. <u>Chancellor Remarks.</u> Chancellor Randy Woodson addressed the group, reminding them of the unique structure of the Council on Athletics. The Council reflects the transparency that's integral

at NC State and represents the key integration of athletics and academics. The Council's role is to provide feedback to his administration on ways to be proactive on select issues within athletics and the guidance is valued. He thanked Dr. Pawlak for serving in the Faculty Athletic Representative role and reflected on the successful 2017-18 year by the athletics department.

4. <u>Guest Head Coach.</u> Coach Kevin Keatts, 2nd year head coach for the men's basketball team, shared his thoughts with the group on the triumphs of the 2017-18 year. He thanked the council for all of their work and additionally noted how proud he is of the strides his team has made in the classroom, with dramatic increases to the team GPA and three All-ACC Academic honorees.

5. Guest Student-Athletes.

- a. <u>Drew Grantham</u>. Drew is a junior on the gymnastics team and is a communication major from Durham. She discussed going through the coaching staff change and the process of learning to buy-in to a new system. She reflected on the team's 2017-18 season and the change in mindset for the team, moving from a 44th place finish in 2016-17 to a 20th place finish and conference championship title in 2017-18. She noted that culture and family is a big focus with the team.
- b. <u>Maggie Tamburro SAAC Representative.</u> Maggie, a senior on the gymnastics team, is the president of SAAC. She is a biomedical engineering major from Hershey, PA. She provided the group with the SAAC priorities for the upcoming year, including: sportsmanship, engagement in the athletics and campus communities, communication, mental health and a holistic approach to community service. Mental health initiatives will once again include Mindful Mondays and a collaborative video message.
- 6. <u>Athletics Updates.</u> Athletics Director Debbie Yow provided the group with updates on the following topics:
 - a. <u>Student-Athlete Engagement Initiatives.</u> She shared with the group a handout that recapped the past several years of training, guest speakers and interactive sessions for student-athletes regarding social issues. She noted that there is not enough time to provide all of the programming that is desired, so the department and teams must be mindful to cover a cross section of topics. One such topic is hazing, which will be discussed with coaches and at an upcoming Captain's Council meeting, as well as at a SAAC meeting.
 - b. <u>Hall of Fame Event.</u> She reminded everyone that the induction event for the 2018 Class will be the evening of September 14th in Reynolds Coliseum. The group should have each received an invitation allowing them to reserve one complimentary ticket to the event.
 - c. <u>Welcome Back Pack.</u> She shared that the department recently had their welcome back dinner for all teams. The speaker was Mallory Weggemann, two-time Paralympian and gold medalist swimmer, who spoke on overcoming challenges.

- d. Men's Basketball. A small group of staff are focused on the men's basketball APR metric and needed improvements. The program is still meeting the necessary 930 standard, but with transfer legislation, it continues to be a challenge. Additionally, she shared that nothing new is known regarding the FBI/Adidas investigation; the trial is expected to begin in federal court in October.
- e. <u>Sports Wagering</u>. She reminded the group that even though federal laws, and potentially increasing state-by-state laws, allow for gambling related to college athletic events, it is still impermissible within NCAA rules for student-athletes and athletics staff members to participate in wagering in any sport for which the NCAA sponsors a championship. The change in federal laws and the confusion of what is allowed is concerning.
- f. 2017-18 Yearbook. Each council member was provided a commemorative picture book that celebrates the success of the program during the historic 2017-18 season, as we finished 15th nationally in overall competitive excellence.
- 7. Faculty Academic Committee Update. Dr. Michael Kanters provided new members with an overview of the FAC, most notably the role they play in certifying continuing eligibility for student-athletes each semester. The committee will plan to meet on December 21st to go through the process for the fall semester. The committee will additionally meet one to two times each semester on topics brought to them by the overall council.
- 8. <u>Update on Standing Committees.</u> Dr. Pawlak discussed the standing committees listed in the council bylaws, most of which are not currently functional. He reported that an ad hoc Committee on Committees met to discuss the work of each committee and will make recommendations to the chancellor on restructuring the work of those committees to better align with modern college athletics. Prior to formal approval by the chancellor, any necessary work can be done by ad hoc committees as allowed within the bylaws.
- 9. <u>Compliance Report</u>. Senior Associate AD Carrie Doyle reviewed new legislation that is based on the work of the Rice Commission that was charged with remedying issues related to Men's Basketball recruitment and summer camps, as well as a new structure for major infractions cases.
- 10. <u>Next Meeting</u>. Next meeting will take place on September 28, 2018 at noon in Talley #3285. Lunch will be provided.
- 11. <u>Adjournment</u>. Having no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 1:32pm.
