- 1. <u>Welcome</u>. Dr. Joel Pawlak welcomed the group and called the meeting to order at 12:03 pm.
- 2. <u>Previous Minutes</u>. The minutes of the November 20, 2020 meeting were reviewed, with no recommendation for edits,

- 3. Guest Head Coach. Dave Doeren, Head Coach for Football, joined the group as the guest head coach for the Council. Coach Doeren expressed his gratitude for Dr. Pawlak for all of his leadership and support of NC State teams and student-athletes. Doeren highlighted essential changes that needed to take place to change the team's culture. Doeren noted the team overcame adversity in the midst of the pandemic by making adjustments with new coaches, players, and the various challenges they experienced from workout restrictions and video review to plaver motivation. Coach Doeren expressed appreciation and pride for his player's ability to overcome these challenges that other teams were not able to. He noted how well his team came together as a family when challenges surrounding diversity arose across the country as well. There were five new coaches that were hired at the beginning of 2020 and the team and staff have developed a great fit and chemistry as a program. Coach Doeren highlighted the team best GPA and anticipation of a strong Spring semester along with a thank you to Ashley Grigsby and the ASPSA team for their help. As the team transitions to the Spring and looks forward to next Fall, they have 3 Seniors that will be returning along with 80% of their players that scored points during 2020. Lastly, the program has two new coaches with Joker Phillips and Ruffin McNeill as great experienced additions to the staff.
- 4. <u>Guest Student-Athlete</u>. Jaeda Daniel, Women's Tennis Student-Athlete, joined the group to discuss her experience at NC State. Jaeda came in as a transfer student from Auburn as a junior studying Psychology and intends to go to law school after graduation. Jaeda noted that after meeting with Coach Earnshaw and the team she loved it here. She also expressed her gratitude for all of the support available to her as a student and athlete. She knows her team is capable of doing great things as they reached a program high of #3 in the country. Jaeda is also Vice President of #PackUnited which became an official student organization this past fall that creates and promotes various initiatives surrounding diversity issues.
- 5. <u>SAAC Updates</u>. Leon Krapf, SAAC President, provided updates to the council.
  - #PackUnited T-Shirt project launched to grow organization funds
  - 1st time ever that an organization was able to market a t-shirt through the bookstore
  - Hosted meeting with Carrie Doyle on NIL and NCAA Legislation for athletes
  - Partnership with Special Olympics
- 6. <u>Athletic Department Update</u>. Athletic Director Boo Corrigan provided a brief update regarding the Athletic Department matters, as follows:
  - Make it noted Wearing a sweatshirt and not a tie
  - 1st time ever where all of our teams will be competing in one semester
  - WBB is #2, Wrestling is #4, Both Swim and Dive #6, Women's Tennis is #12, Men's Tennis is #14, and Baseball is in the top-15
  - Academics All-time best GPA as a department
  - Athletics Department added a new position approved to oversee ACC Network → potential for additional revenues
  - Budget projection of 20-25 million, now is closer to 12-15 million

- 7. <u>NCAA Legislative Update</u>. Carrie Doyle, Sr. Associate AD for Compliance, provided an update regarding ongoing NCAA legislation.

  - 25 states with legislation surrounding NIL
  - 2021 will be a fascinating year with NCAA Legislation and its impact on college athletics
