## **OLD BUSINESS**

PO 325 : Aspects of Animal Welfare – Approved with Suggestion

Discussion: This new course was presented by Santos. Suggestion to add week ranges to modules on topic outline.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

• Consent Agenda - Approved

Discussion: The consent agenda was approved. No critical feedback was shared.

AEC 260 : Global Change Ecology - Approved with Suggestions

Discussion: This new course was presented by Pratt Philips. Suggestion to edit "critically evaluate management practices" in SLO #4. Suggestion to add week ranges in the topic outline.

AGI 194 : International Learning Experience in AGI – Tabled

Discussion: This course was presented by Pratt Philips. Discussion pertaining to the splitting of credit hours across semesters - one credit hour in one semester, and three credit hours in another semester. Committee expressed that the course should be divided into two courses. Due to extensive changes, the course was moved to table so that the instructors have time to correct the syllabus and consider moving the course into two separate courses.
