WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

- Remarks from Chair Jonathan Duggins Welcomed the committee and reminded everyone that Fall Break is upcoming.
- Remarks from OUCCAS/DASA Li shared updates regarding the CIM for Courses Refresh, specifically highlighting changes to rename, reorder, clarify, and group fields for an improved form-filling experience. The on-site consultation took place last week and the beginning of Spring 2025 will be User Acceptance Testing with more time to hone updates. Interested parties should contact lamarcus@ncsu.edu to be added to the user testing group, Lexi shared that OUCCAS is offering in-person CIM labs on October 22, and 23, 2024 with details and registration available through Reporter. - Approval of the UCCC Minutes from UCCC Minutes September 18, 2024
 — Approved
 Discussion: No discussion was initiated by the committee regarding the minutes.

OLD BUSINESS

• ACC 458 : Accounting Analytics: From Data to Decisions - Approved Pending

Discussion: This returning course was presented by Proxy Taylor. One of the reviewers noted that the syllabus has not yet been reviewed. The proxy asked if the action had to be tabled; Chair and Lexi stated that it could be moved forward approved pending the review and approval of the syllabus. Course was approved pending approval and review of the syllabus.

NEW BUSINESS

• Consent Agenda - Approved with one removal

Discussion: The consent agenda was moved and seconded to approved. Member Kosenko requested that ENG 384 be removed from the consent agenda pending a consultation with the Department of Communication. The remaining courses on the consent agenda were approved.

FW 295: Special Topics in Fisheries, Wildlife, and Conservation Biology - Approved

Discussion: This new course was presented by Roise. This is an experimental topics offering. Reviewer made a friendly suggestion that the SEMs should be specified or "varies by topic" to better match the guidelines:

■ PDF- UCCC Subcommittee Recommendations . Li noted that there is no way to share outcomes with different content; the experimental shell is to try out various objectives depending on course content/student interest for the ultimate purpose of flexible course offerings. Members had questions about the nature of experimental topics offerings,

asking about how structure can be integrated in such a flexible course. Li responded by suggesting that the inclusion of clear grading methods (such as letter and S/U) as well as some general course outcomes are advisable inclusions. Li shared the following document pertaining to suggested practices: UCCC "Suggested Practices" Working Document

• PRT 261 : Nature, Health, and Wellness - Approved with Suggestions

Discussion: This new course was presented by Roise. Reviewers noted that the course is very wordy and thorough. The course goals and objectives are a repetition of the SLOs. Friendly suggestion to change the course goals and objectives, removing the duplication and/or replace the SLOs with GEP objectives. Friendly suggestion to change the topic outline to be less detailed for the reason that a more general topic outline prevents smaller changes like updates to reading lists from being put into the workflow again. Friendly suggestion to look into some of the typos and make small edits as needed. The course was approved with suggestions.

• Latin Certificate - Approved

Discussion: This curricular action was presented by Kosenko. Reviewer shared that they weren't quite sure what to look for while reviewing a certificate. All reviewers stated the overall certificate looks fine. No further discussion was shared.

• ACC 452 : Accounting Practicum - Approved Pending

Discussion: This new course was presented by Proxy Taylor. Presenter shared general context about the course and how it was taught previously in a different capacity and the department is seeking to create a permanent offering starting in Spring 2025. Reviewer asked why the course is listed as non-repeatable for credit; the presenter noted that it's unlikely anyone wouldn't pass the course and they're not sure they'd have the capacity to have another practicum attendee. Course was moved pending approval of the syllabus.

Discussion: No discussion was initiated or shared by the committee. Chair called the meeting to adjourn.
