1. The meeting was called to order by Mike Edwards, chair. It was determined that a quorum was present and the meeting could conduct business.
2. The minutes of November 12 were approved.
3. Ingrid Schmidt (committee coordinator, Assoc V Prov for Global Engagement) gave a brief update on the current timeline for the University Strategic Plan, and the upcoming project by CIP and IOC members to collect quotes in support of global engagement for advocacy purposes.
4. Three presentations were provided on the theme of student programs and support related to the new Global Learning for All strategic framework. Presentations included requests for input from committee members, and time for questions and discussion.

Robin Dorfman, Program Associate for External Relations in the Office of Global Engagement, presented on global internships, both current virtual internship placements at companies in other countries, and plans for an in-person internship program this summer in Prague. **The application deadline for Spring 2021 virtual programs is January 4, and committee members were asked to encourage their students to apply.**

Jonathan Brewster, Director of the NC Japan Center, described OGE's newly launched pilot COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) initiative. The presentation included current examples of COIL programs with partner classrooms in Japan, as well as transferable best practices. **Committee**

**members were encouraged to consider incorporating COIL components into their own courses, and to watch for announcements of seed grants supporting this work.**

Michael Bustle, Associate Vice Provost for Global Engagement and Director of the Global Training Initiative, presented a selection of current student programs offered by GTI, which support the Global Learning for All framework. Highlighted programs included the Cultural Exchange Network (CENet), the Developing Cultural Competence Certificate (DCCC), and the Global Education, Academics, and Research Skills (GEARS) program. **Committee members were asked to encourage their students to participate in programs such as CENet and GEARS, and to consider hosting in their labs a visiting international student participating in the GEARS program.**

Slides from each presentation were added to the committee's shared folder, and can be provided to interested members of the campus and wider community if requested.
