 - a. These will be made more visible to students from the first day they set foot on campus.
 - b. International experiences for students are high impact practices
 - iii. CIP's role in COIL promotion
 - 1. Several units on campus (OGE, OFE, DELTA) are working together to standardize and make transparent COIL/virtual exchange resources.
 - a. DELTA will host all COIL courses through Moodle beginning Summer 2024
 - b. The Office of Faculty Engagement will host materials and workshops for NC State faculty on how to build a COIL component into an NC State Course
 - c. OGE will serve as the campus COIL "matchmaker" – NC State faculty looking for international COIL collaborators and our international colleagues looking for NC State faculty COIL partners can request matching assistance through OGE office
 - d. A COIL/virtual exchange strategic plan is in the works, and this plan will be incorporated into the new QEP within the first two years of the QEP launch.
 - e. The COIL strategic plan/white paper will be presented to QEP leadership in March 2024
