- ii. Digital Extension and Digital Literacy - are they one area to flesh out, or should they be broken apart into two areas?
 1. Could be a softball idea with a partial narrative that we throw out to the university
 2. Joe Sutton and Greg Raschke could work together on this
 - a. Frame extension as a driver of excellence
 - b. Vicki Gallagher will help with revision and refinement
 3. Thomas Millar Goals of higher education
 - a. Should we add a section about extension?
 4. Vicki Gallagher- Try to articulate “being a leader in aligning the future of public university in a time of multiple disruptions.”
 - a. Also, articulating clearly “digital literacy”
 5. Eric Wiebe- AI component
 - a. Try to interweave throughout the document by June 1
 - b. AI has been under recognized
 - c. Real time information for agriculture and factories that can improve operations.
 - d. Melissa Pasquinelli- Citizen Science, individuals helping collect data
 - i. Greg Raschke- Connection to Public Engagement
 - e. Tom Miller- center for educational informatics, James Lester’s lab
 - i. The highest productivity research group in all of computer science
 - ii. Projects on the application of AI and education
 - iii. More focused on K-12 than higher ed
 - f. Eric Wiebe connected to the center’s development of intelligent tutoring systems
 6. Mark Williams on infrastructure piece
 - a. Mindset of what you want to be thinking about
 - b. Jill Sexton and Donna Petherbridge please take a look at the infrastructure piece
 - i. Jill wonder if it should be its own piece or if it should be interwoven throughout the document
 - ii. Jill is trying to figure out what we want to see vs how we do it
 - c. Greg Sparks indicates that we have great ideas, but we have to have support to be able to do things we want to do
 - d. Greg Raschke- Don’t need to worry so much about implementation, but can recognize that it is a challenge.

- e. Kelly Wick- If it is something the task force feels strongly about then put it in the document. This is a chance to articulate the needs for digital transformation in higher education.
 - 7. Vicki Gallagher wants this to be about vision and priorities. At the end of the document- what kind of investments are required to make this high tech and touch?
 - a. Tom Miller- ideas paint a picture of where we want to be what we need to be. Resources we need to build to make this happen.
- e. Plans for the fall in terms of the university?
 - i. UNC system set June 1st deadline to submit plans for the fall
 - 1. Right now we believe this is going to be a blended learning environment for the fall
 - a. Combination face to face and online
 - b. Try to provide the experiential and residential learning components
 - ii. The faculty survey is full of lots of great information and will be public soon
 - iii. The reward and incentive structure will be greater
 - iv. Going to have more readers looking at instruction innovation because of our trajectory for the fall
