## **Task Force Charges:**

- 1. Describe the central challenges facing NC State that are key to our success in this area;
  - Communication gaps internal and external
  - Decentralized nature can be a challenge opportunity to enhance programs to synergize our partnerships fully across the University
  - Need for enhanced central database of who we have at the university (talent / research areas)
  - Need for enhanced central database of partnerships
  - Need for more defined metrics / captured metrics on strong / successful partnerships
  - Need for enhanced media around successful partnerships
  - Enhance cultivation of students from day 1 advising, student success, services, customer experience, graduate employability
  - Lack of physical space / diversity and type of space on campus for partners
- 2. Provide a brief overview of where we stand relative to facing those challenges, including initiatives that were started in the Pathway to the Future Strategic Plan, including progress made;

  - Generally feel good about how the university is handling IP agreements
