Introductions and Orientation to the University Library Committee

- Kerry Havner, Zac Harris, Gary Little, Chirag Gajjar, and Art Cooper volunteered for the Institutional History Subcommittee.
- Suzanne Kennedy-Stoskopf, Taylor Rogan, Alice Warren, Zac Harris, and Gary Little volunteered for the Food Service Task Force.
- Mike Hyman, Zac Harris, and Nancy Powell volunteered for the Alternative Textbook Review Committee.

Budget Outlook for the Fiscal Year

- A substantial number of students are asked to leave Hill or Hunt each night due to the reduction in hours.
- Because of budget cuts and 6% yearly inflation, 600-700K in journals was cut last year.
- The next round of cuts is expected to be ~1.2-2%, or roughly ~300-400K plus enrollment increase money for the Libraries.
- 27 positions have already been cut, and 7 more librarians have been hired away. The Libraries are 11% below pre-Hunt staff levels.
- 2-3 more years of this is expected, so with the committee's help, the Libraries will have tough decisions to make.

Report on New Hours

- 1700 students have been asked to leave so far this semester as a result of the reduced hours. The Libraries is still gathering data.
- The Wolfline extended its hours to 3am.
- Both Libraries will be open overnight during the exam period.
- Zac Harris pointed out that he chose NC State in part because of the Libraries and finds it unfortunate that the hours have been reduced.
- Paul Williams asked why ETF can't be used for Libraries personnel as it is in other units and if a separate Library Fee could be instituted as it is on other campuses. He invited Susan Nutter to meet with the Faculty Senate's Resources And Environment Committee to discuss this fee.
- Chirag Gajjar asked about a continuing allocation for Hunt. Carolyn Argentati confirmed that ETF has been grandfathered for colleges, but will not be expanded to other units.

Proposed Rule Change Related to Lost/Returned Materials

- The proposed change would impose a 6-month window for requesting refunds when a lost overdue item is found.
- Susan Nutter would like to separate technology and other materials under this policy.
- Michael Hyman suggested using a rental service.
- Susan Kennedy-Stoskopf and Paul Williams suggested a two-tiered policy, one for frequent offenders and one for first-time offenders.
- Kerry Havner would like to see the notification process clarified and would like for the consequences to be explicit. A previous notification prior to a block might be helpful.
- Walt Wessels suggests a "soft" block that results in limited access and asked that a revised version come up for discussion at a future meeting.

"Ask Us" Service Center in DH Hill

• Like Hunt, DH Hill now has a single-service point ASK US desk. Under this model, users can request help from Libraries staff members from wherever they are in the building.

Plans for Renovation and Sprinkler Installation in the DH Hill's West Wing

- The Graduate Commons and Visualization Studio are both open.
- There will be sprinkler work going on this semester in the West Wing.
- The Faculty Conference Room is now available, but still needs to be outfitted with technology.
- Work on the Makerspace in underway.
- The Libraries will be coordinating with the Faculty Senate staff, University Dining, and Registration & Records on closings and interruptions related to the work being done on the Faculty Research Commons.
