#### 1) Capital Campaign Update - Leia Droll, Executive Director of Development

- The university's \$1.6B capital campaign will be going public this Friday. Unit goals throughout the university represent size and capacity of donor base for that area.
- The Libraries has initiated the Sad bookBot campaign as a part of the university goal to educate students about philanthropy (Penny Wars, etc.). It is a campaign centered around naming the only unnamed bookBot arm, with names suggested and voted on in a couple of tiers. Funding will support the Libraries' Student Enrichment Endowment. Social media will be a big part of this campaign.

### 2) Collections Update - Greg Raschke, Associate Director for Collections and Scholarly Communication and Hilary Davis, Head for Collections and Research Strategy

- Please give GR feedback and input on this budget before Collections and Research Strategy finalizes this year's budget.
- Collections plan is to invest in more resources to support interdisciplinary research and emerging research areas.

- The Libraries is not looking at cuts for this fiscal year. The Libraries looks at impact factors, CPU, and feedback from campus when looking at resource cuts. Since the last round of cuts, staff have been keeping track of ILL requests for cancelled journals, and have been able to reinstate when needed.

## 3) Proposed Change to Spring Break Hours - David Goldsmith, Associate Director for Materials Management

## 4) Virtual Reality and Augmented Reality at the NCSU Libraries - David Woodbury, Associate Head, Learning Spaces & Services; and Pete Schreiner, NCSU Libraries Fellow

- The NCSU Libraries are exploring VR/AR technologies with the same approach as approach to Makerspaces: make technologies available, create community, provide support and services, and host an exploration and creation space.
- DELTA and the NCSU Libraries were involved in developing the NC State Virtual Reality Group.
- The Libraries hosted "Virtual Friday" events at the D.H. Hill Library, with over 100 people at each event, and have performed outreach at other visualization-focused events.
- The Libraries has approved a "scratch space" for AR/VR technology support at the D.H. Hill Library.
