#### We Acquire both Ebook & Print Formats

- Community-driven, data-informed
- Users expect instant access
- Location agnostic anytime, anywhere
- Flexible business and user models
- Average ROI ebooks = \$2.96/use



#### **Complex Factors that Influence Acquisitions**

- User expectations
- Increasing interdisciplinarity
- Publishers' business models & access models
- Holdings in TRLN
- Funding

#### **Just-in-Case Selection**

- Core, must-have titles
- Approval plans
- Ebook packages from university presses, major publishers (e.g., Springer, Wiley, Elsevier, IEEE, Oxford University Press)
- Title-by-title selection

#### **Just-in-Time Selection**

- Demand-driven (DDA) records all formats (but ebook preferred)
- Curated set of records, scoped by our criteria
- Quick workflow for patron experience
- Provides access to over 60,000 titles without always having to purchase

#### **TRLN and Interlibrary loan network**

- We borrowed 28,000+ items from other libraries in FY 15/16
- Extend our collection by leveraging TRLN collections
  - $\circ$  50% of borrowed books from TRLN
  - 2.6 days turnaround time
- NC LIVE
  - 24,000+ ebooks available



#### Number of Books - 11 Year Trends

- Doubled number of books made available to patrons
  - In FY 2005/06 we added ~ 53,000 book records
  - In FY 2015/16 we added ~108,000 book records

- Added 1 million books in last 11 years
  - In FY 2005/06 our total book count was ~1.8 million volumes/records
  - In FY 2015/16 our total book count was ~2.8 million volumes/records
