

FY18 BUDGET UPDATE

2017-18 Budget Outlook

- NCSU is projecting a loss of about \$11M in campus enrollment funding in 2017/18
- Fewer avenues to combat lost funding
- Provost stressing that units need to be selfsufficient and strategic with financial resources

Libraries Beginning Budgets – State Appropriated 2012/13 to 2017/18

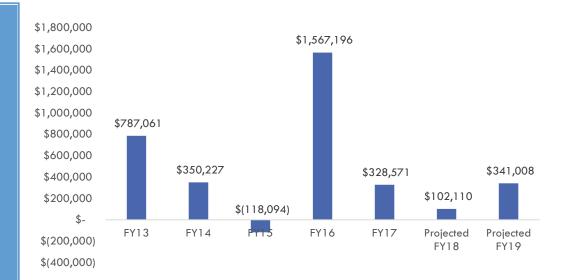


This chart reflects the Libraries' FY18 beginning state appropriated budget with new projected funding for SHRA raises, EHRA raises and enrollment changes. (\sim \$324K)

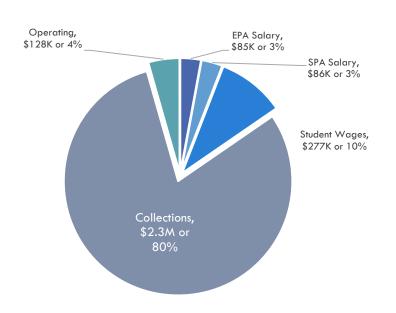
Libraries Enrollment Funding

From 2012/13 to 2016/17, the Libraries has received approximately \$2.9M in enrollment funding increases.

2014/15 was the only year with an enrollment funding decrease. FY18 projected change is \$102K and FY19 projected change is \$341K.



Libraries Enrollment Funding



Over the past five years, 80% of enrollment funding has been budgeted for the Libraries' collection.

Originally there was a sizable reduction for the Libraries in 2017/18 with a projected significant enrollment growth in 2018/19.

TOTAL 2017/18	\$102,110	\$341,008	\$443,118

Now the plan is to limit FY18 reductions with the goal of attaining enrollment targets over the biennium.
