South elevation of the south stacks tower, facing the Brickyard.



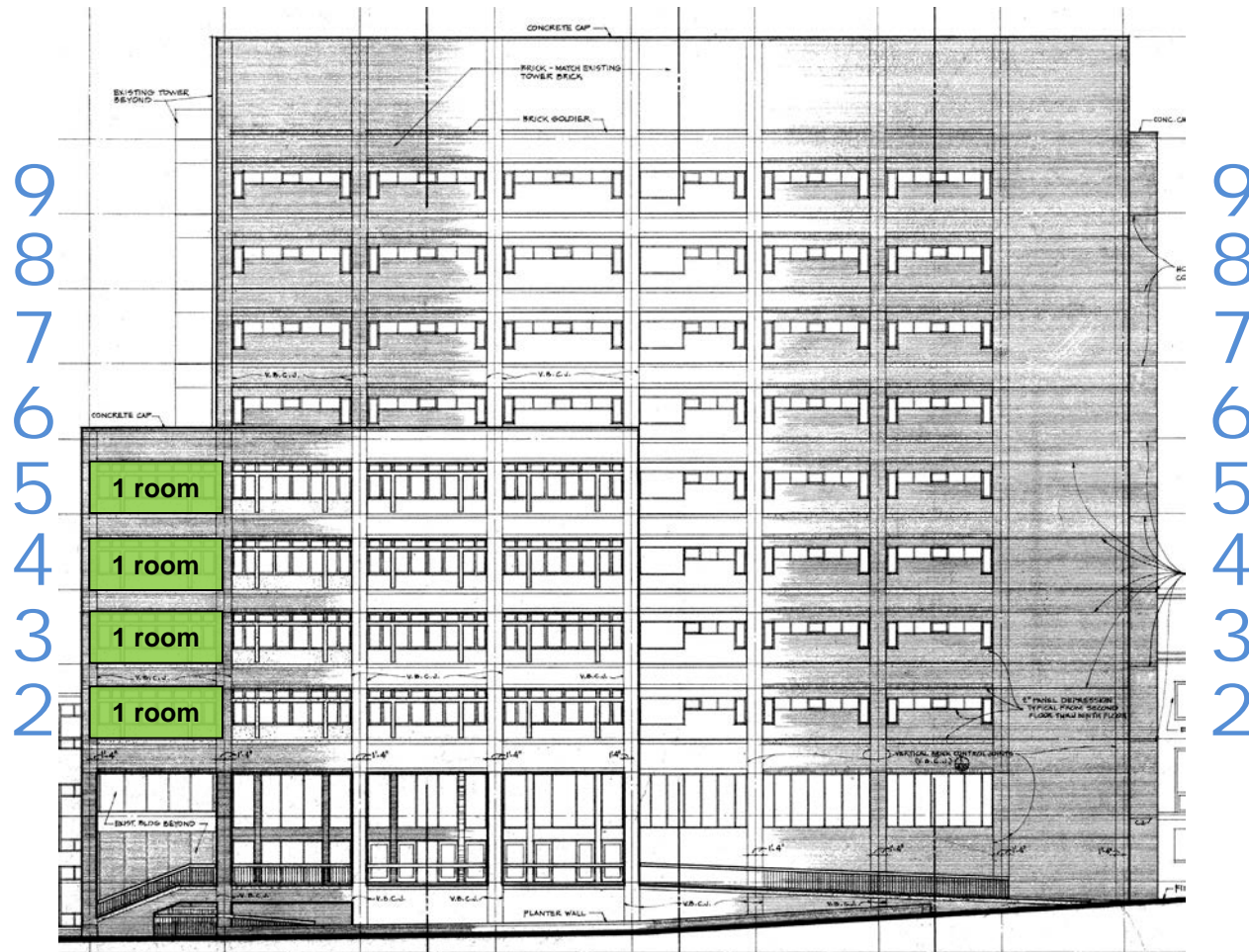
Existing arrangement of group study rooms in the south stacks (20 rooms)

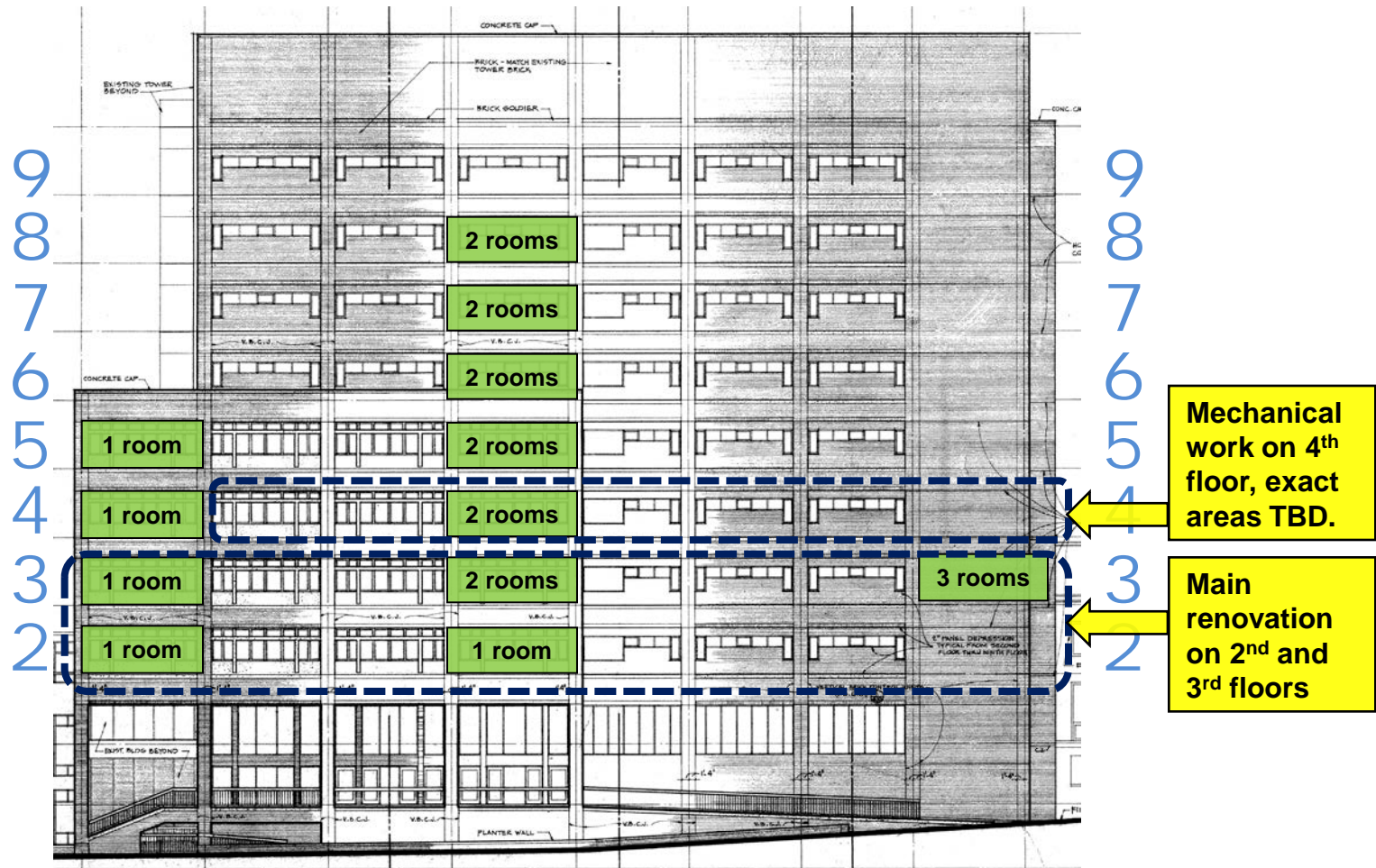

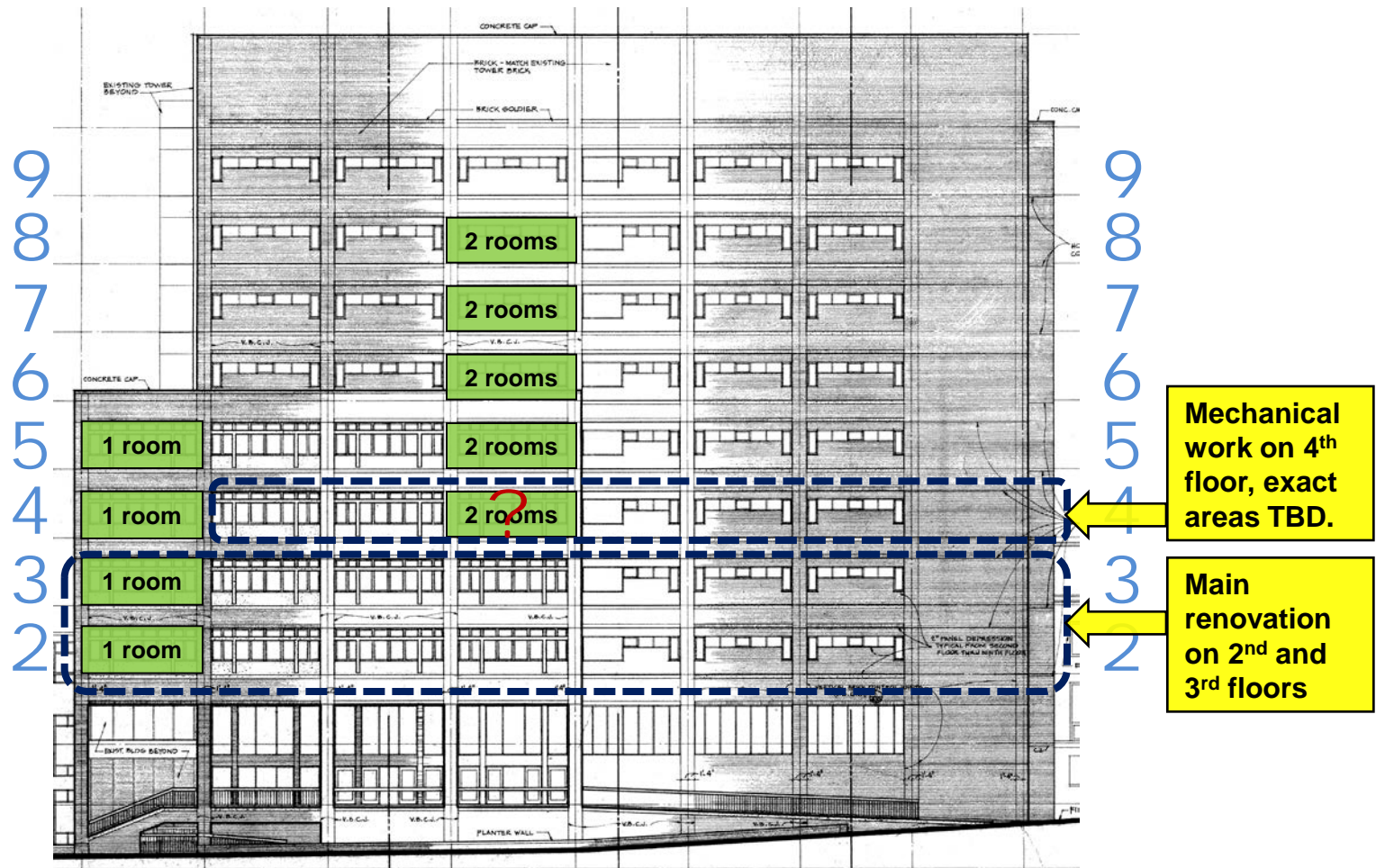
Existing arrangement of group study rooms in the south stacks (20 rooms)



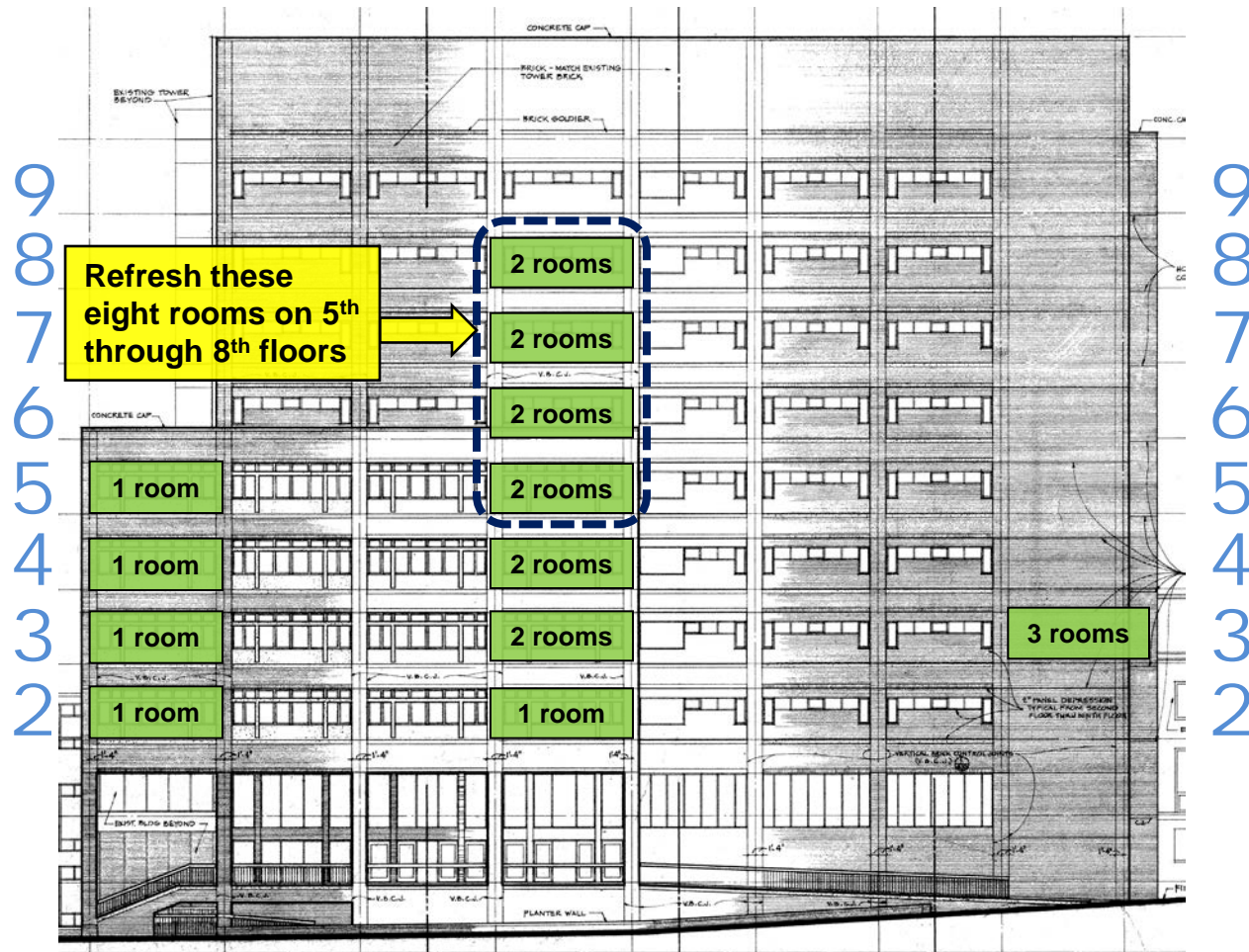

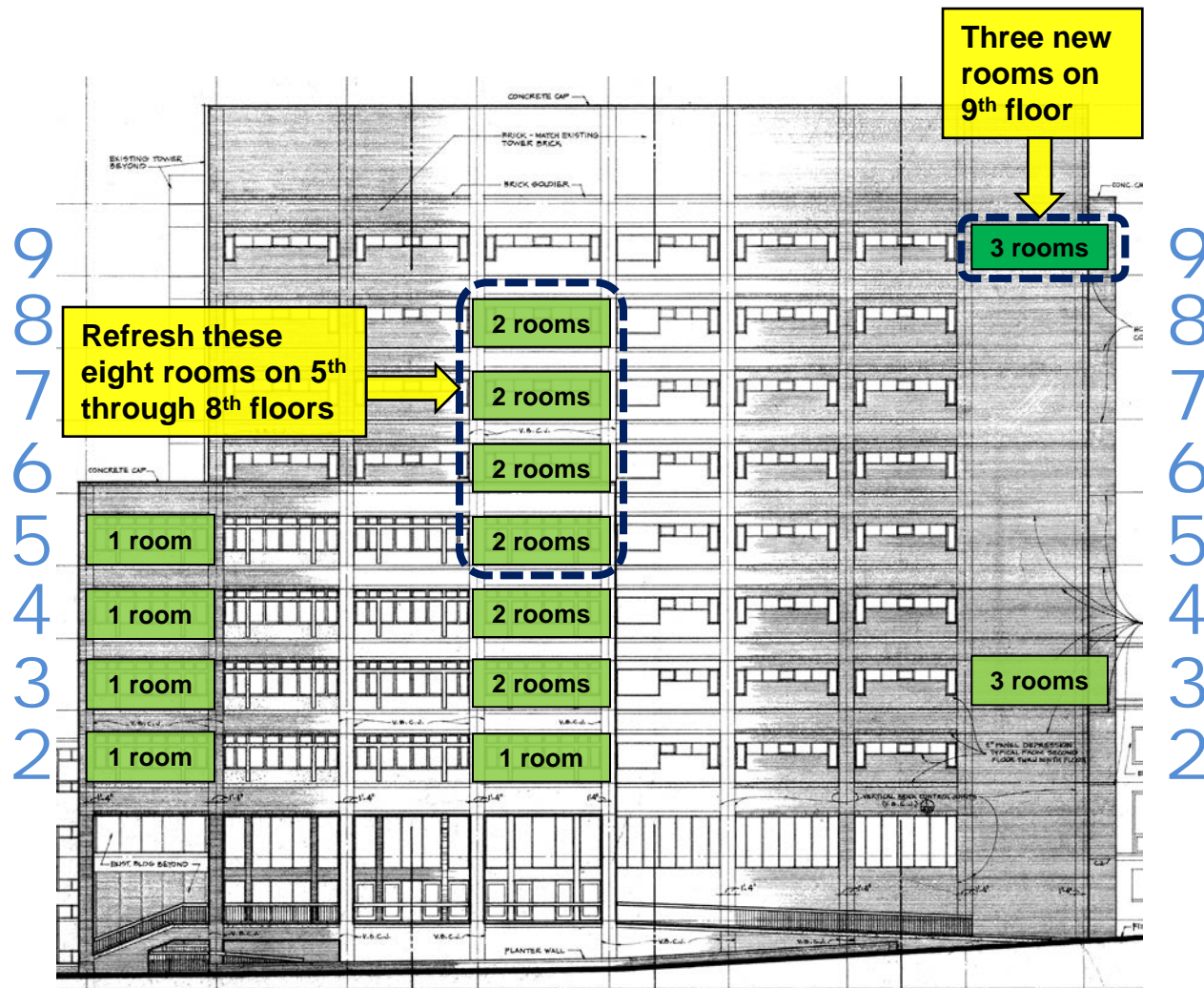

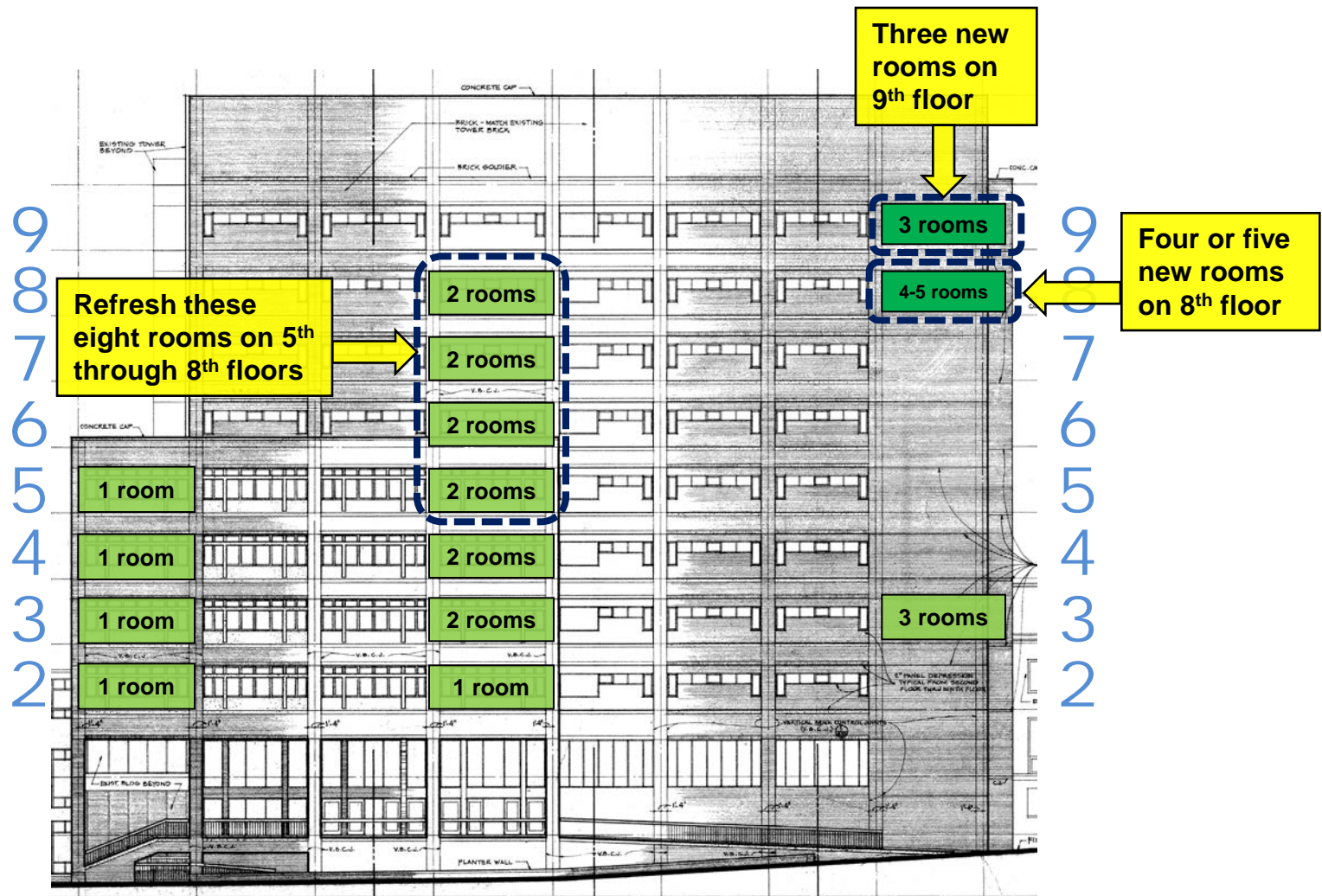
Renovation areas and impact on group study rooms after construction (August 2020)



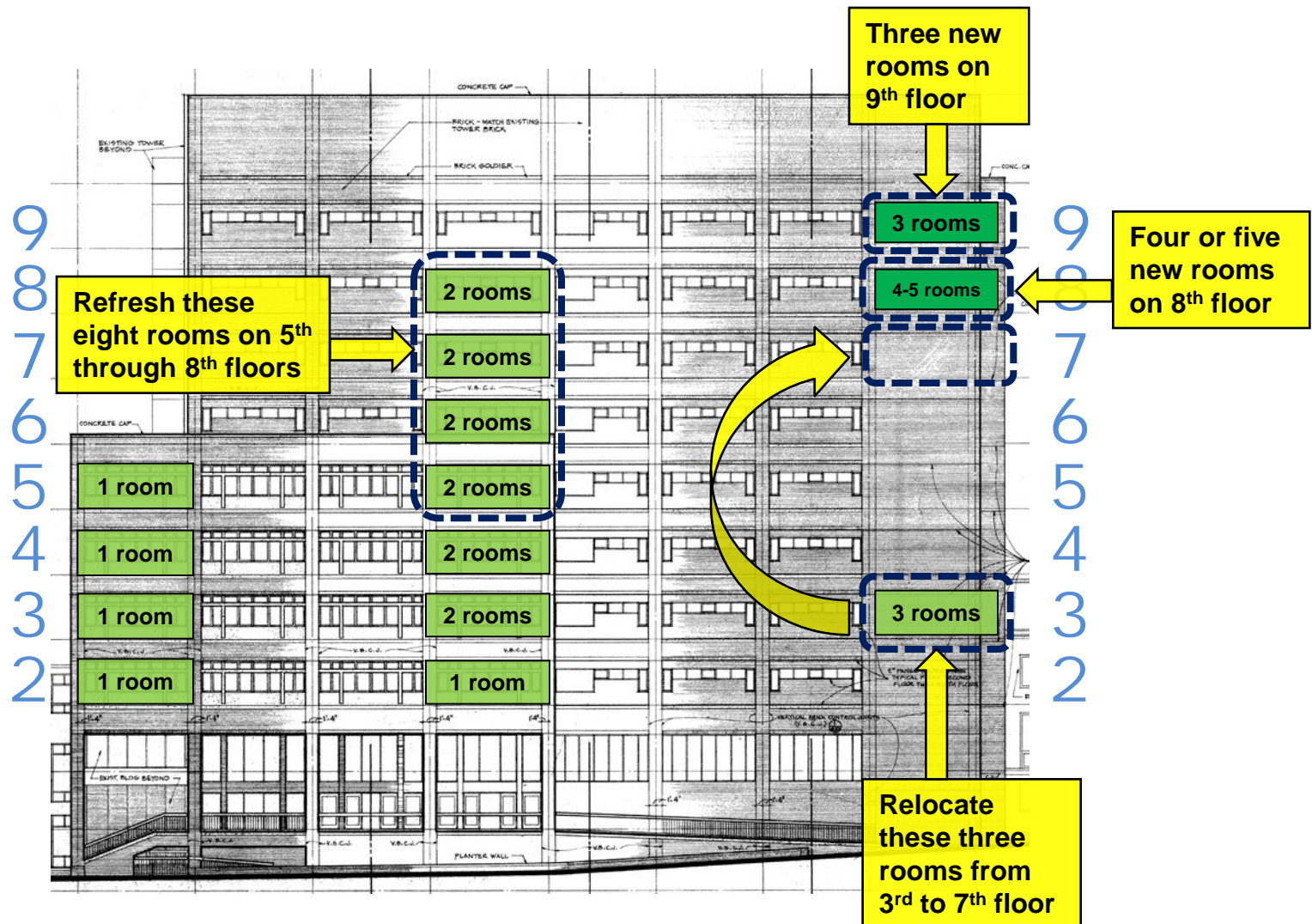

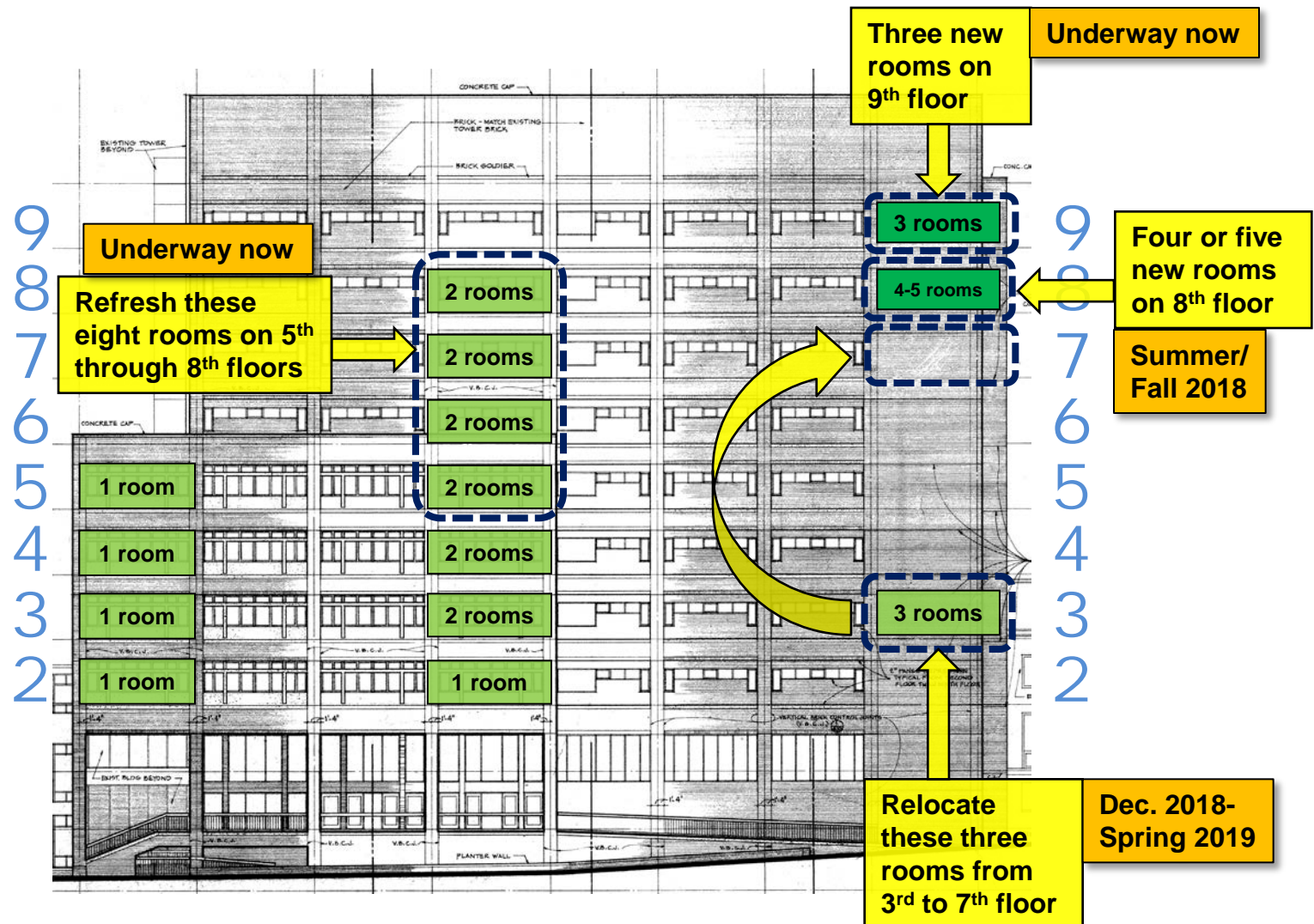

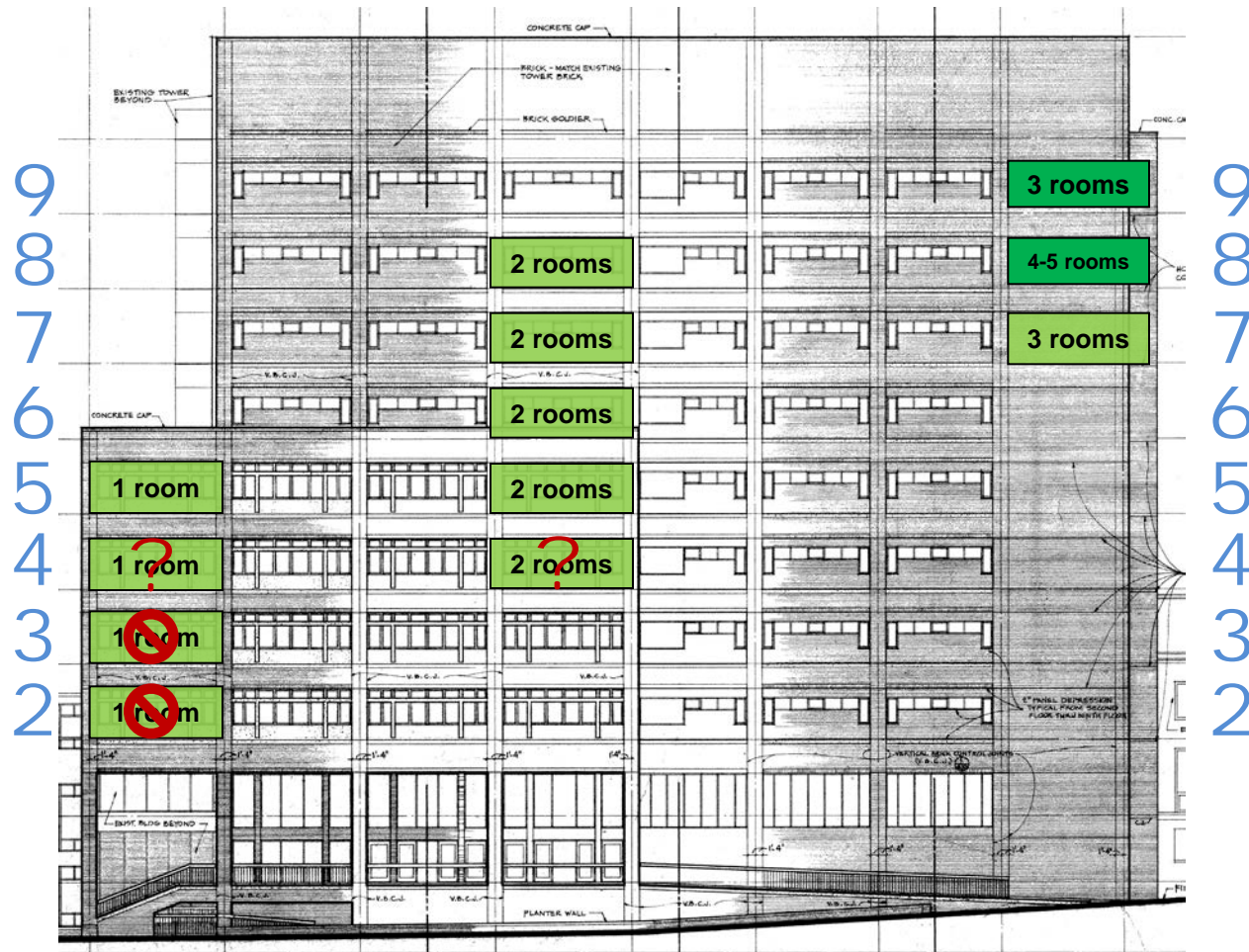

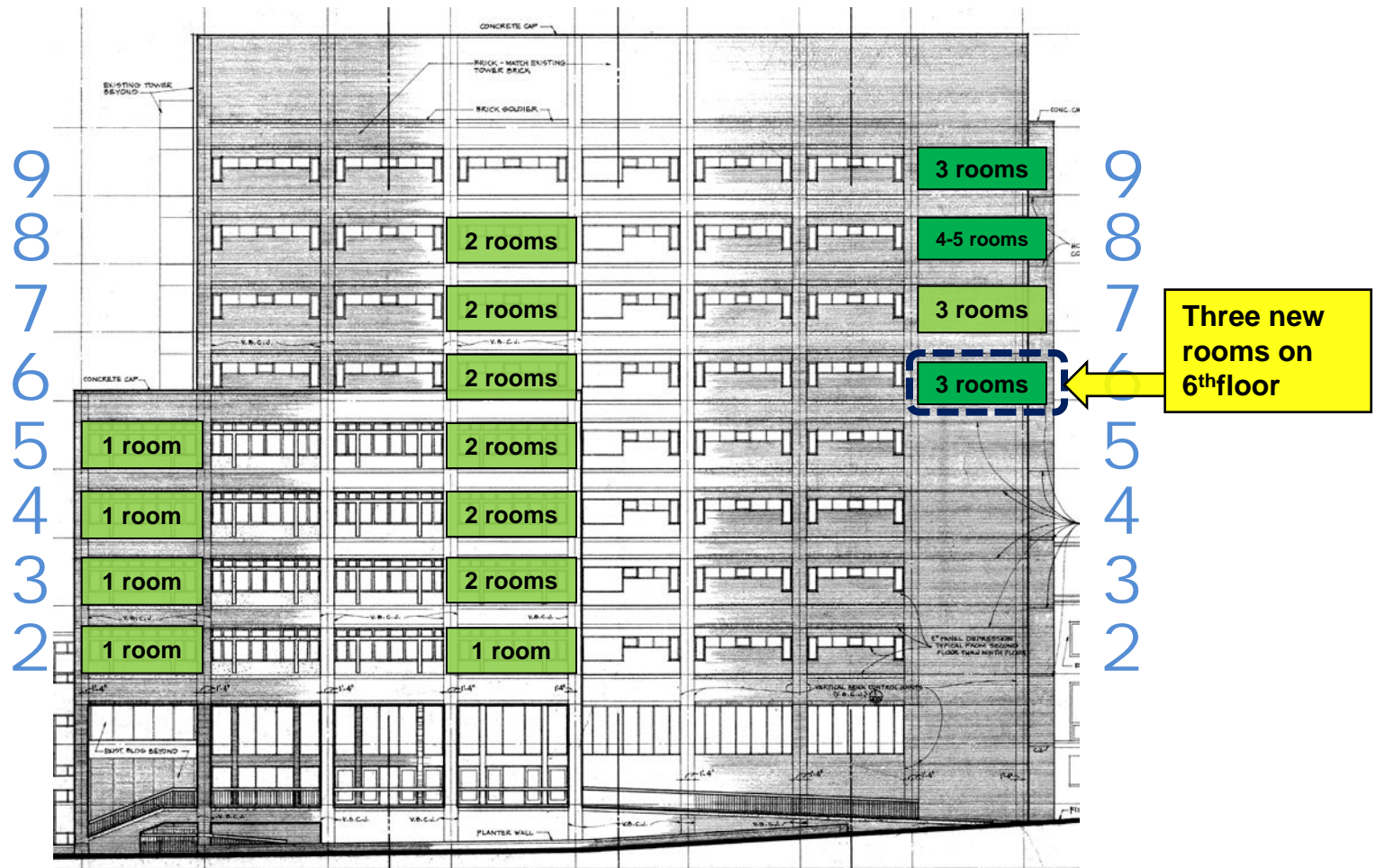

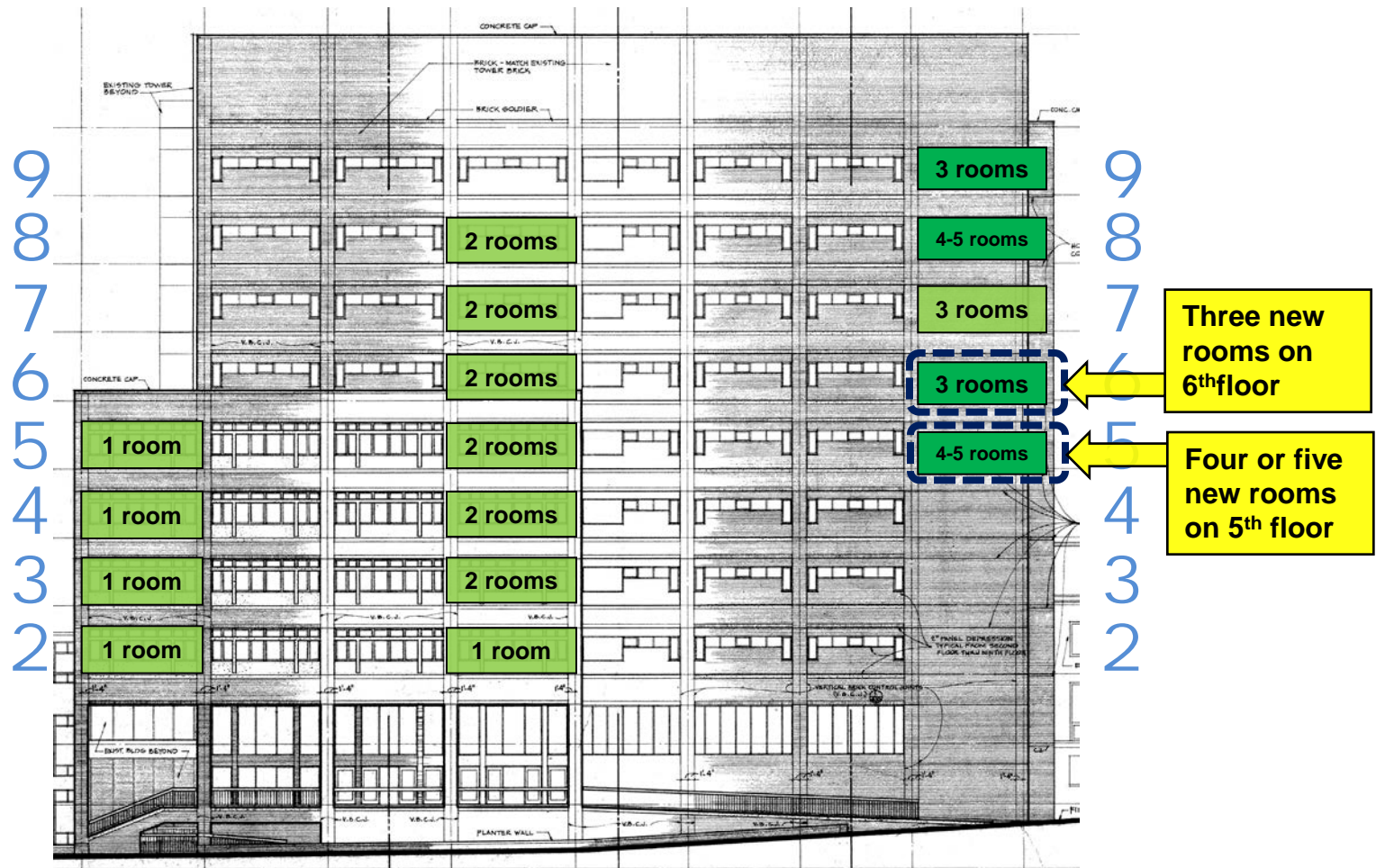

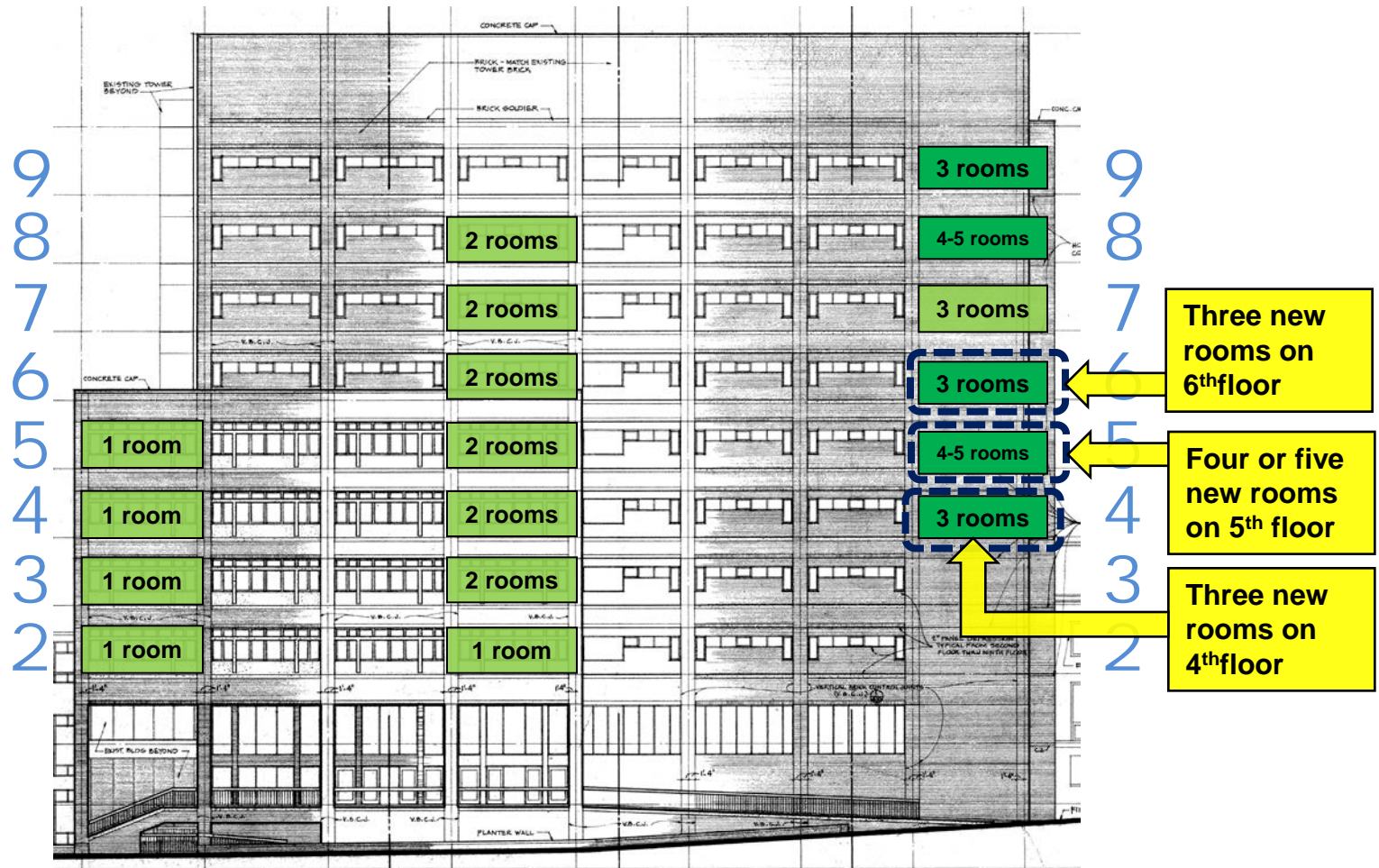
Arrangement of group study rooms at the beginning of construction (19-23 rooms), May 2019



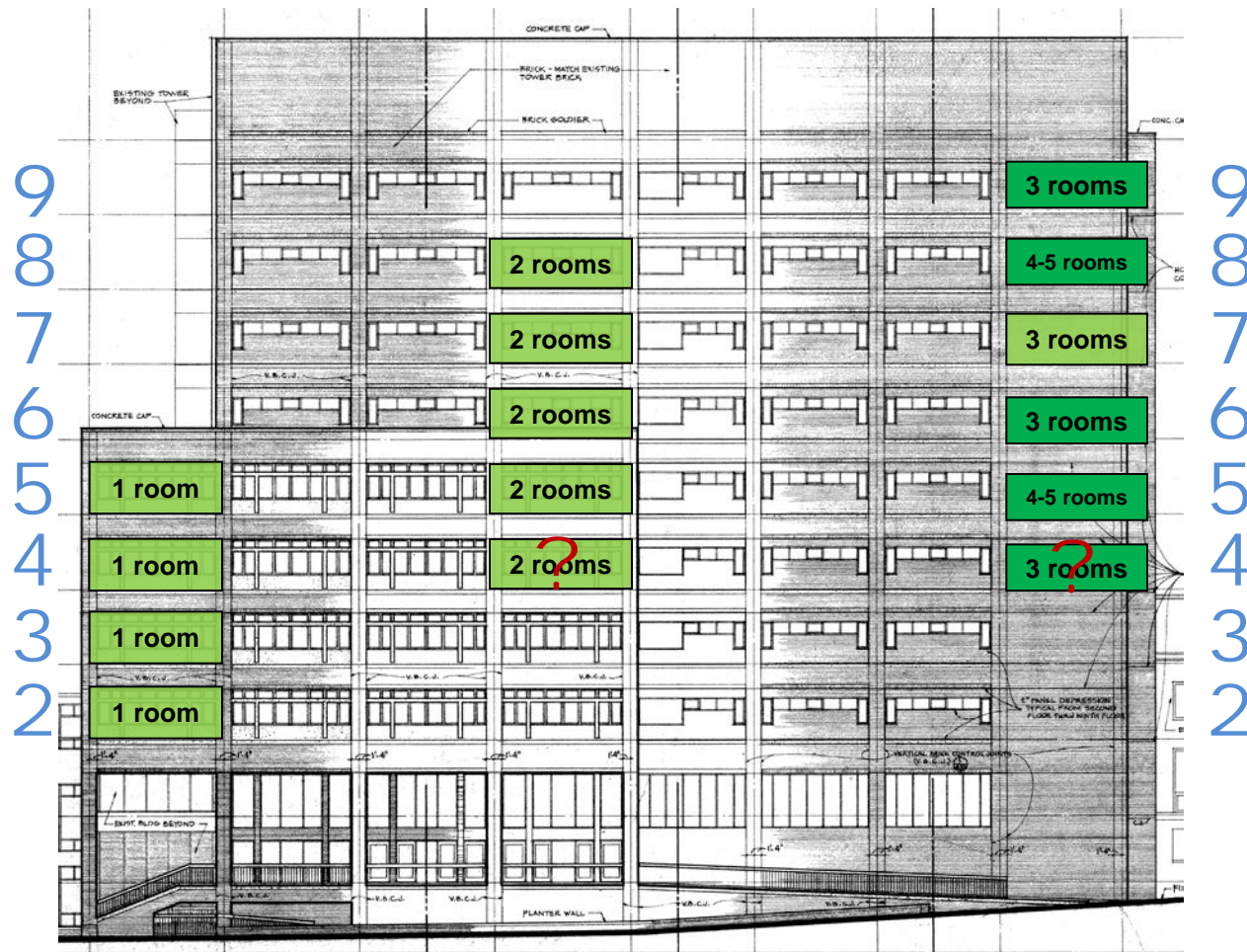

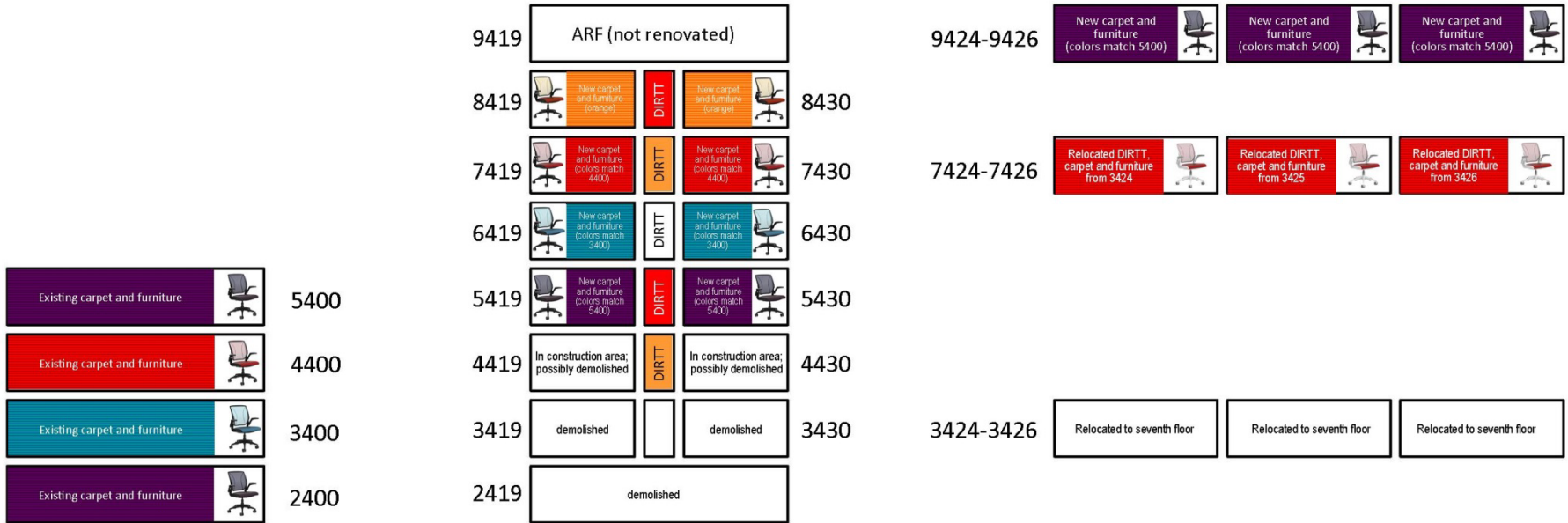
Arrangement of group study rooms if all projects are implemented (29-36 rooms)

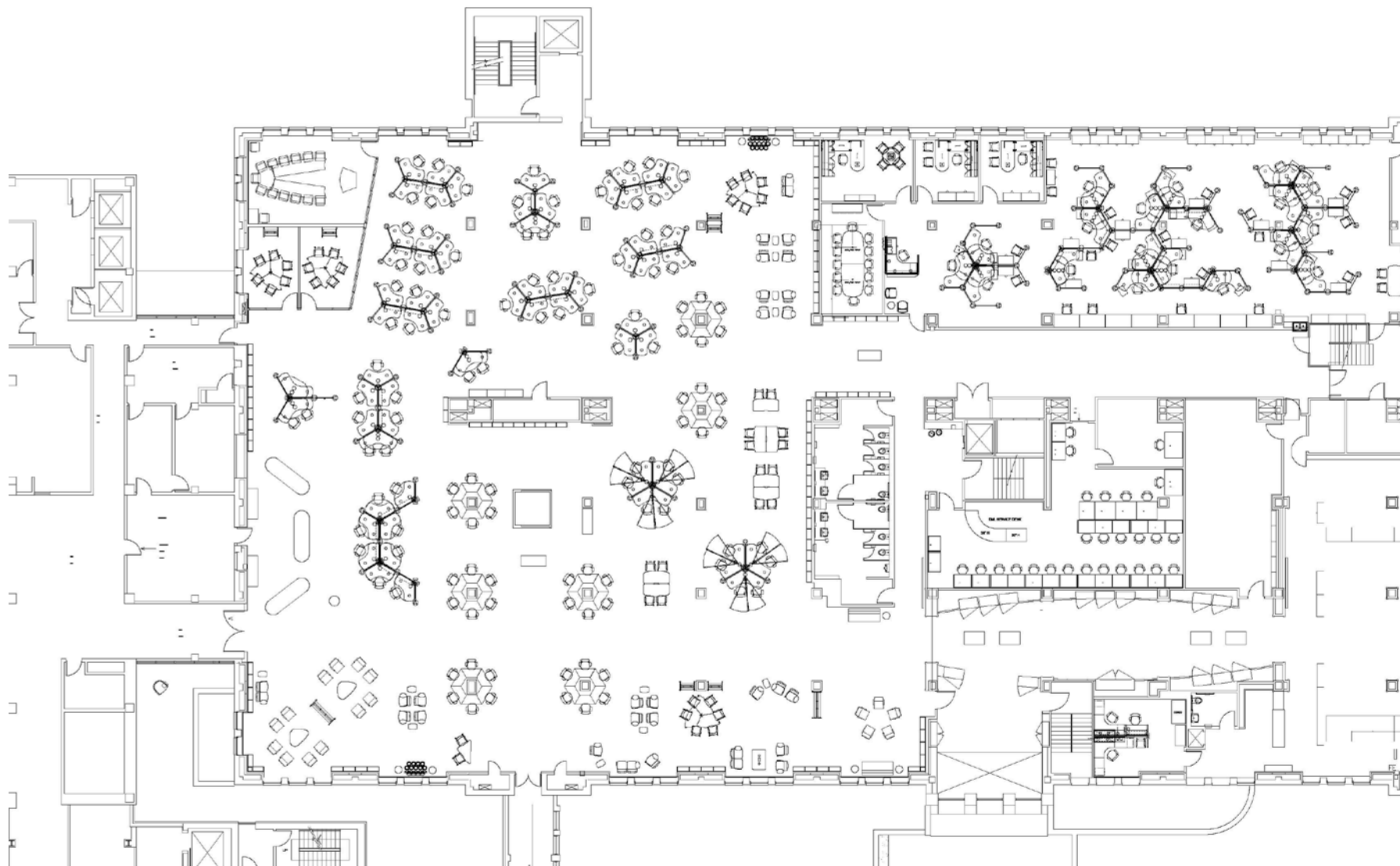

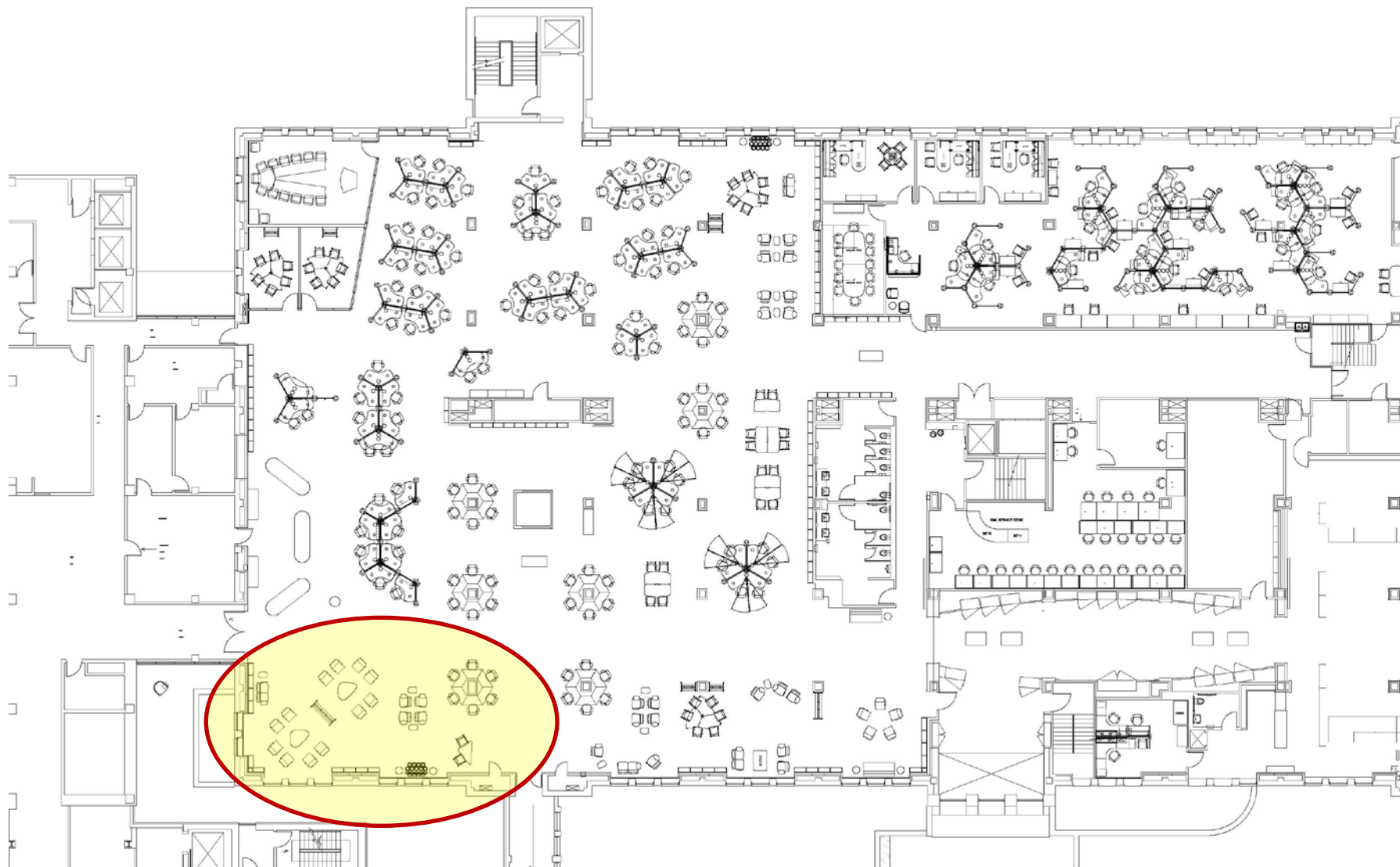

Unattractive views through windows, with little daylight

Insufficient ambient lighting along perimeter



North edge along major circulation route is not defined

Install wood grille panels over existing windows. Wood to match bookshelves.

Add ambient lighting along perimeter, either in ceiling, on top of bookshelves, or with floor lamps.

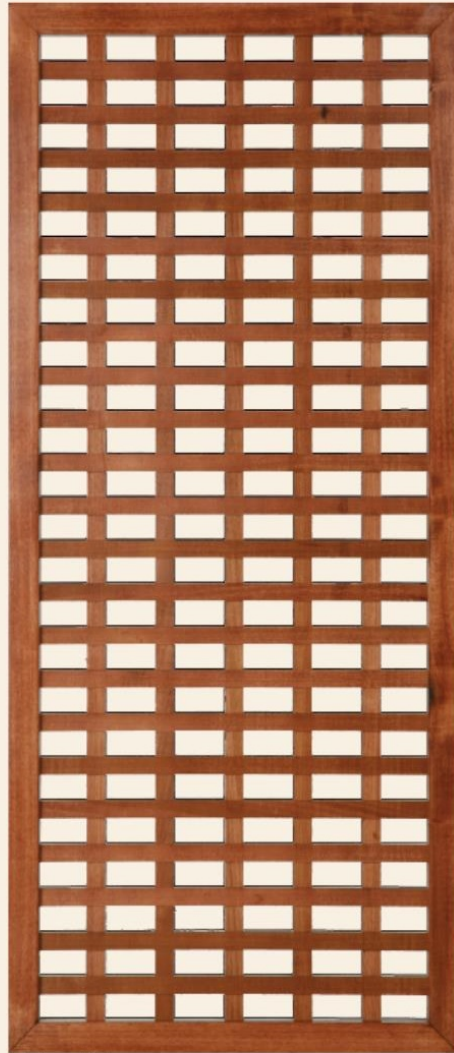


Consider adding new modular seating and tables under windows to give a built-in appearance. Re-arrange remaining furniture in the area.

Add two area rugs (relocated from staff conference rooms on ground floor) to help define the area.

Add new low bookshelves along north edge. New bookshelves to match existing.
