



NCSU Libraries ARL Rank Without One-time Adjustments FY 2005/06 - FY 2015/16



NCSU Libraries and NC State Peer Group's Collections Expenditures




NCSU Libraries and NC State Peer Group's Collections Expenditures¹ Per Faculty Member² FY 2015/16
