SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTIVITIES OF COMMITTEE

Shifting Drop/Revision Date

- Student Mental Health Taskforce review recommended extending Drop/Revision deadline from 50% of the term to 60% (example, if in Fall 2024 it would look like October 17th to October 24th).
- UNC Systems Regulation allows course drops up to the 60% point in the term. Many other Universities in the UNC System also follow this deadline at the 60% point.
- This revision would allow students additional time to make informed decisions after midterms.
- Committee was in support of shifting the date with considerations being given to student support staff/advising season/

Priority Registration

- A new approval process for priority registration proposed start Fall 25 registration window. The goal was to put together the strategies for which requests will be evaluated. This committee was tasked with helping to make decisions in the future and with developing the rubric used to determine which student groups are placed into priority registration buckets (overall priority or level priority).
- Currently, in some capacity, 46.3% of students have priority registration.
- Reassigning groups to priority registration will start from scratch. Everyone interested must submit a request.
- 15 requests submitted with 9 being approved
