## Special Topics/HON Course Offerings

 IPGK 295 "The Struggle of the Free Press: Fake News & Conspiracy Theories" (IP, GK) – Approved with Suggestions

Darby explained the previous meeting's review and why the course returned to the committee, particularly with regard to the specifics of the interdisciplinary nature of the course. Members moved to approve the course. Reviewers stated that the clarity was improved.
