## **NEW BUSINESS**

### Courses New to GEP

# BIT 214 : Biotechnology and Sustainability – Approved with Suggestion

Discussion: This new course was presented by Dorfman. Carlos Goller was in attendance to represent BIT 214 and responded to a reviewer's concern about the IP SLOs, particularly LO 6. Suggestion to change wording to "history and systemic inequities" in LO 6. Instructor included additional course resources <a href="BIT 214 Resource 1">BIT 214 Resource 1</a> and <a href="BIT 295 Course Map">BIT 295 Course Map</a>.

There was a suggestion to include SLO 5 in objective 3, since it would also fit.

#### • PRT 261 : Nature, Health, and Wellness – Approved

Discussion: This new course was presented by Pacifici. The course was moved to approve with no further discussion.

Discussion: Discussing Implementations of the Federal Contracting Compliance Memo and reviewing recommendation draft

Chair shared that the recommendation draft will be presented to the Faculty Senate on February 18. Chair walked through the draft explaining each of the points within the summary of recommendations. Members shared various viewpoints and points of clarification, making some wording suggestions to the recommendation draft. Faculty expressed a desire to have the normal process documented to display the contrast with the current mandate as well as notations regarding effects on students and disciplinary/accreditation concerns. Members agreed to continue working on the document prior to sharing it with their representative groups along with a mechanism for wide feedback early next week.
