SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTIVITIES OF COMMITTEE

- Substantive discussion item: Change to the charge of the committee. During the Fall semester, the charge of the committee was modified to shift undergraduate academic appeals for continuation from the University Admissions Committee to a newly created Academic Appeals Committee. One of the justifications for adjusting the committee is to ensure that membership contains 12-month staff professionals, faculty, and administrators who are able to review appeals over the summer and during the winter break. Given that the bulk of the appeals have justifications based on mental health struggles, additional benefits of shifting to an Academic Appeals Committee is that members of the committee would be selected based on their expertise and proximity to student support structures on campus including the student success center, counseling services, and college-based support programs.
